

The Transition Assistance Program (TAP) is a congressionally mandated program that provides information, tools and training to ensure Service members and their spouses are prepared for the next step in civilian life. NDAA FY20 mandates that all service members attend TAP no later than 365 days prior to separation/retirement. The TAP journey is a four step journey: Step I: Initial Counseling: In person meeting with a TAP counselor.

Step 2: Pre- Separation Briefing: Course offered monthly at the MSFRC

Step 3: 5 day Course: A week of classes that include courses from Department of Labor (DOL) & Veteran's Administration. Step 4: Capstone: Completion of all required documentation to TAP counselor and the final signatures on the e-form.
