

How to Make Your Disneyland Theme Park Reservations

Thank you for your order!

Please reserve your park dates as soon as possible.

Option 1: Use the Disneyland App

(Light blue background with a white castle icon)

1. Open the **Disneyland App**
2. Tap the “+” at the bottom → Select “**Make a Park Reservation**”
3. Choose “**Make or Modify Park Reservations**” → Log in or create a Disney account
 - (Your Disney+ login works here too!)
4. Select “**Book Theme Park Reservation**”
5. Tap “**Link a Ticket or Magic Key**” → Enter Ticket ID numbers
 - Ticket ID is at the top right of your ticket under the QR code
 - Add each ticket by selecting “**Add Another ID Number**”
6. Assign **first & last names** to each ticket (child tickets to children, adult tickets to adults)
7. Select your party → Click “**Book Theme Park Reservation**”
8. Pick your **date** and **park** from the calendar
 - Park Hopper: first park is your starting point, hop after 11 am
9. Agree to terms → Repeat for all visit days
10. Watch for **confirmation emails** in your Disney account inbox

Option 2: Use the Website

Visit: disneyland.disney.go.com

Follow the **same steps** as the app—just on your computer instead of your phone.

Pro Tip: Be sure to book a reservation for **each day** you plan to visit.

Important: Assigning Tickets to Each Guest

- When making your reservation, you’ll need to scan the QR code on each ticket and enter each guest’s first and last name.
- Even if your printed tickets all show the same name, you’ll still assign the correct names to each ticket during the reservation process.
- **Note:** Make sure child tickets are assigned to children and adult tickets to adults.
