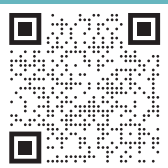

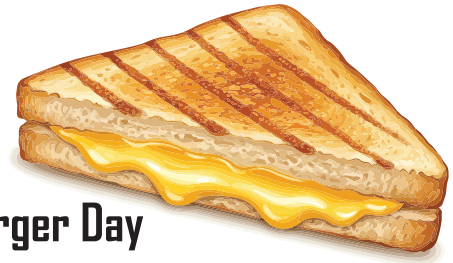

## Ready to Transition Out?

### Transition Assistance Program

Start planning your transition at least 365 days before separation—or 18-24 months before retirement. The Transition Assistance Program (TAP) helps you and your family get the tools, guidance and information needed for a smooth shift to civilian life.

#### TAP Process:

**Initial Counseling:** Meet in person with a TAP counselor to assess transition readiness, develop an individualized transition plan, and schedule required briefings.

**Pre-Separation Briefing:** A one-day monthly briefing covering benefits, entitlements, required actions, and resources including TRICARE, VA disability, and community support agencies.

**TAP 5-Day Course:** Focused workshops on employment preparation, financial readiness, and VA benefits, led by TAP staff, a financial counselor, Veterans Affairs, and the Department of Labor.

**Capstone:** Final session to review your plan and confirm all requirements are complete.
